PRAYER

(1 Pet. 3:12) The following from the pen of Batsell Baxter is timely: "The alien sinner - the man who has never become a child of God - cannot pray his way into the kingdom. He cannot substitute prayer for obedience; but as he obeys the Lord, he can do so in a prayerful spirit every step of the way. But the very moment that he stops and refuses to obey a command of the Lord he is turning away his ear from hearing the law. Christians need admonition here. We are God's children. With us prayer opens the door to God's throne of mercy, and Jesus intercedes for us (Heb. 4:15-16); but by the stubbornness of our hearts in refusing to obey some command

of the Lord we can close that door until we get rid of our stubbornness and obey the command. Let us as christians be careful that our prayer is not an abomination to God."
