



If you have been listening to the radio and reading your news-paper for the past few days, you no doubt know about the Catholics under guise of the Italian Government prohibiting members of the Church of Christ in Italy to assemble and worship. According to the newspapers no reason has been given for closing the 22 congregations in Italy except "its evangelical activities in converting Italians in Catholic Italy." About 1000 Italians have become members of the Church of Christ for the

past five years.

During world war II Americans fought and died to free Catholic Italy from the Nazi-Fascist regime. At the end when they were supposed to be "liberated," their constitution was supposed to include and guarantee "religious liberty, freedom of assembly and freedom of thought." They freely admit this is in their constitution. But the Catholics have taken the law into their own hands and have interfered with these liberties that our boys helped to establish. When we were there helping them to win a war, they did not say, "get out." When their friend Mr. Truman, wants to send an ambassador to the Vatican they don't say, "stay home," or "get out." No they think they might get a little firmer grip on America if this is done; but let some one disagree with the Catholic religion and they are ready to go to any means to exterminate them.

(RELIGIOUS INTOLERANCE Cont.)

This proves that they are alike so far as principle and policy are concerned.

Of course this is no new thing, for Catholics have persecuted so-called "protestants" down through the centuries. They have declared in their writings that "All heretics should be put to death," and all who oppose Catholicism are heretics according to them. They have put thousands to death, because they would not bow to Catholicism. And they would do it today if they were in Power in this country. They are doing every thing they can do, to get control of this country, and have made many inroads into our government. May the Lord pity us when the day comes that Catholics will rule our country.

The "tolerance" of Catholicism is very remarkable indeed! They deny "Protestants" the right to religious liberty in Italy, while they enjoy full religious freedom here in these United States. Not only are they allowed religious freedom, but they are also permitted to establish numerous "secret" orders here, by which the Pope maintains a steady pressure to undermine our liberties, and to destroy the constitution of our great country.

Our brethern are not in Italy to undermine their government or to take anything from the Italians; Neither are they there to "dabble in politics," or to change their government in any way whatsoever. They are there to lead a benighted

people from the errors of Catholicism to the Savior of men. To help them see the glorious light of the Gospel of Jesus Christ which is God's power to save. (Rom.1:16)

Members of the Church of Christ have always been perfectly willing for anyone to investigate their teaching and to compare it with the teaching of Christ and His apostles. We believe that God's Word is the standard by which all religions should be measured. Our bre thern in Italy would welcome the opportunity to debate any of our religious practices with any representative of the Catholic church even the Pope. This is a much better way to settle our differences. We stand ready at all times to defend our teaching and our practice in honorable debate with any who would challenge it. Let us who are Christians "earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." (Jude 3)

Let us pray fervently unto our Heavenly Father, that our brethern in Italy may have the courage to stand in the face of all opposition, and that the Church of God may continue to go forward in Italy.

Let us write our Congressman and urgo him to use all the influence he may have, to relieve the unfortunate situation.
