

4. The building of gigantic armaments, when the real enemy was within; the decadence of the people.

5. The decay of religion; faith fading into mere form. Losing touch with life, and becoming impotent to guide.

These reasons for the fall of the Roman Empire are sufficient to make people of the twentieth-century stop and think---or are they?
