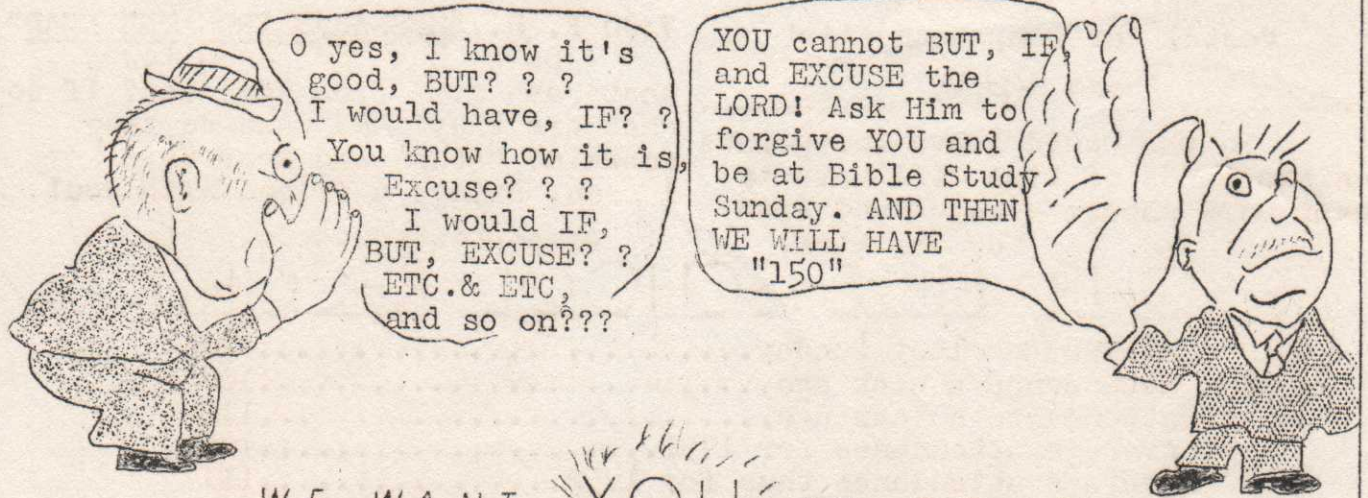

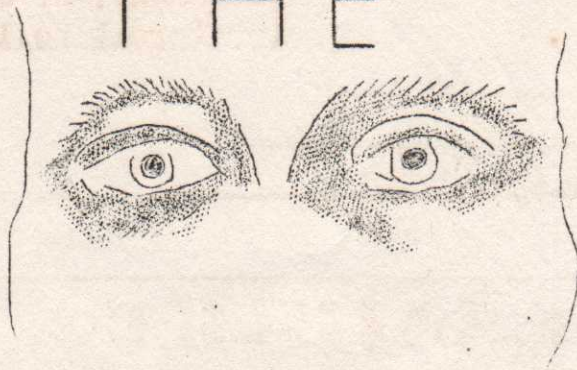

Well, what of it? The rich man was satisfied, but God called him a fool and took away his soul. Luke 12:20.

The whole church in Laodicea was satisfied, but Jesus said they did not know that they were actually wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked. That's how wrong a satisfied person can be. Rev. 3:17-18.
