Are You Persuaded?

I. We must be persuaded to become a Christian

- A. Example: Acts 26 – King Agrippa and Paul
- B. We must realize that wrong has been done by us all (Rom. 3:10, 3:23, 6:23, 2:5)
- C. We must realize that the ungodly, unrighteous things that we are doing and the rejecting of response is to God (Acts 9:5, Rom. 2:4)
- D. We must be bothered by it to the point to do something about it (Acts 2:37, 16:29-31, 22:16, Mk. 16:16, Acts 2:37-38, 41)

II. We Must Be Persuaded TO BE a Christian

- I. Disciples of Christ have to be a convicted people (Jn. 8:31-32)
- II. Paul had to persuade the Christians to remain faithful (Gal. 6:7-10, 1 Cor. 1:10, Phil. 3:12-16, 1 Thess. 4:1-8)
- III. The Hebrew writer had to use persuasion for the Jewish Christians to choose Christ over the Law of Moses (Heb. 2:1-3)
- IV. Same for us – Heb. 3:6

III. How Do We know that we have been persuaded?

- I. Have we responded to become a Christian?
- II. Have you changed the way you think, live, or act because of your knowledge of the Gospel?
- III. You know you have been persuaded by the actions you are doing.
