



"IT DOESN'T SAY HE THAT IS NOT BAPTIZED SHALL BE CONDEMNED"

Jesus said: "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mark 16:16)

Those who oppose the truth on the divine design of baptism are in the habit of consoling themselves with the fact that while Christ says that he that believeth not shall be damned, they say he does not condemn the unbaptized man. Selah!

Every one stands condemned at the first point of disobedience. This is proper and right and just what Christ in the commission does. He condemns one at the point of unbelief, without waiting to see if he disobeys by refusing to be baptized.

"He that buys a ticket and gets on the train shall be transported; he that does not buy a ticket will be left." Would it not be absurd to add to the last clause: "and gets not on the train?" If a man does not buy a ticket he is not eligible to get on the train.

Even so, if a man is not a believer he is not eligible to be baptized. But if a man were saved by believing, without baptism, then it would be logical to say that a man is transported only by buying the ticket without getting on the train!

The fact of the matter is that the people who say that baptism is not essential to salvation also say that a man is saved the very moment he believes. That is tantamount to saying that a man is transported to his destination the very second he purchases the ticket! If he that only believes is saved when he believes, and with no further acts of obedience, then he that buys a ticket to New York is there with no act of getting on the train necessary.

Everyone knows that unless the person that buys a ticket gets on the train, he CANNOT be transported. Cannot those who understand that, also understand Mark 16:16? Notice the parallel: "He that buys a ticket AND gets on the train shall be transported." "He that believeth AND is baptized shall be saved." (Mark 16:16) If one is capable of understanding the first he is also capable of understanding the second. If not, why not?
