

CHRISTIAN UNITY

One of the most pathetic passages in the New Testament is to be found in St. John 17: 21-22 where Jesus prayed so earnestly to the Father that all of his disciples all who come to believe on him might be one. He gives a good reason for this great desire: "That the world may believe that God sent me ".

In I Cer. 1:10 Paul says, "Let there be no divisions among you." Denominational Division among the believers has made more converts to infidelity and scepticism than to the Lord. Men who never study the teachings of Christ lay the blame for confusion and division at the feet of Jesus. It does not belong there. If man had for the past 1900 years, looked to Jesus through the New Testament for his instruction in religion, the world of believers would not be divided today.

Instead of so doing, then have confused teachings of the Old Testament with some in the New Testament mixed with the OPINIONS OF MEN and therefore, few leaders in religion today can give you a respectful reason for what they believe and practice in the name of Christianity. For this reason few men can defend what they teach by the Word of God.

Denominationalism in its divided state does not represent the religion of the Christ of New Testament, but came as a result of the Reformation, "reforming Rome" and is therefore a reformed system of Romanism. You can prove the above statement by taking a look at the relics of Rome in various Denominations.

The only way to produce the UNITY for which Jesus prayed, is as follows:

Destroy all creeds, disciplines, articles of faith, catechisms and all authority of men in religion and all names not authorized by the Lord and let all believers look to Jesus Through his only message, the New Testament, become Christians as he pleads by faith, repentance, confession and a burial by baptism, thus entering Christ, they live for him. Thus all believers will become "ONE" and God will be glorified through his Son.
